Gentlemen:

Carmen Copper Corporation (CCC), an operating mine of Atlas Consolidated Mining Development Corporation (AT) based in Toledo City, Cebu confirmed that around 4:15pm Monday (December 21, 2020), a slide happened at the Carmen Pit, CCC's mine operations site.

The incident was traceable to the incessant rains for the past several months and aggravated by Typhoon Vicky which hit parts of the Visayas, including Toledo City last Friday, December 18, 2020.

The Management of CCC is doing all the necessary action to assess and address the overall situation. We will continue to inform the concerned agencies as well the general public of further developments.

We do not see any material impact on AT's 2020 financial performance as our Business Continuity Process is in place which allows other functions of CCC to perform with minimal stoppage.

During this temporary suspension of mine pit operations, CCC will be working hand in hand with the government agencies to determine when it can safely resume normal operations.

The above information is being disclosed in accordance with the disclosure rules of the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") and the Philippine Stock Exchange ("PSE").
