Dear Atty O.E. Baylosis:

This refers to your letter dated 14 December 2020, duly received by this Office on 28 December 2020, requesting for the issuance of certification relative to the status of the mining rights application of Atlas Consolidated Mining and Development Corporation (ACMDC).

Please be informed that as per records of this Office, the application for Exploration Permit of ACMDC denominated as EXPA No. 000073-XIII was endorsed to the Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB) Central Office on 6 June 2011, for further evaluation and approval. However, on 23 August 2019, the subject application was returned to this Office due to the following findings:

1. The applied area falls within the watershed area of the Tago River Irrigation System; and

[Note: Tago River Irrigation System or Tago River Watershed is not included in the list of proclaimed watershed forest reserve in Caraga Region but is considered one of the 142 critical watersheds in the country based on the data provided by the River Basin Control Office of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR). Be it noted, that the Watershed or Forestry Zone is under Layer 10 of the subdivisions of Strategic Agricultural and Forestry Development Zone (SAFDZ) which is deemed possible Go Zone pursuant to the Memorandum dated 28 July 2014 of then MGB Director Leo L. Jasareno unless they are closed to mining pursuant to DENR Administrative Order (DAO) No. 2010-21¹ and Section 4 of DAO No. 2012-07².

Item a.3, Section 15 of DAO No. 2010-21 provides that, **"critical watersheds with appropriate barangay/municipal/city/provincial Sanggunian ordinance specifying therein the location and specific boundary of the concerned**

area are considered as areas closed to mining applications”.

Relative thereto, as per data gathered from the concerned Local Government Units (Province, Municipality and Barangay) and Provincial/Community Environment and Natural Resources Offices of the DENR it was found out that no related **Sanggunian Ordinance** was passed declaring Tago River Watershed as a critical watershed. As a result, the area is considered as Possible Go Zone considering the aforesaid facts gathered. **However, this Office is still constrained to return the subject application to your end due to the protest submitted by the Sanguniang Bayan of San Miguel, Surigao del Sur per Resolution No. 67, Series of 2008³.**

2. Non-compliant with the meridional block system requirement.

As of this writing, EXPA No. 000073-XIII of ACMDC is considered **valid and subsisting** subject to compliance of the noted deficiencies.

This letter therefore serves as **Certification** in compliance with Section 17.14 of the Revised Disclosure Rules of the Philippine Stock Exchange.

The pertinent Evaluation Result of MGB CO is attached for your ready reference.
